Ugh. Another rainy day, and I'm unloading Nightwatch supplies, with rainwater dripping down my neck. A homeless guy offers to help. I look him over. He's carrying three garbage bags, and a wet blanket. Drops of rain are falling from his backpack. "I've got it, thanks!" I tell him, and then offer him a dry blanket, waterproof jacket, and some new socks.

He continues to offer help, but because of COVID I can't let him into the building. He pulls a negative COVID test from his pack and thanks Nightwatch for offering testing on-site.

"That recent test result can get you into shelter, if you want it," I told him. "Interested?" He instantly said

"YES!" and thanked me repeatedly for caring. I explained the shelter rules and asked if he thought it would work for him. Tears welled up in his eyes.

He helped me load things onto the cart outside, and pushed it to the door. "Thank you for letting me give back the only way I am able."

When I came back to work at 9:00 pm, he was there, ready to go to shelter for the first time. He gave me back the dry blanket. "Somebody is going to need this more than me."
